## Hong Kong Science Park Site Visit

Phase two of the Hong Kong Science Park covers a site area of 7.7Hectares and includes ten high-tech buildings of glass, steel and aluminum consistent with the character of the park on the south end of Pak Shek Kok Reclamation Area in Shtin, bounded by Tolo Harbour.

There are two inclined erezg towers, two dedicated laboratory buildings as well as six research development buildings, two of which have provisions for laboratory facilities.

A focal point of the development’s centre is a free-standing, oval-shaped auditorium on the central spine connected to a lake via timber decked areas with al-fresco dining on one side and, with its gentle, contours, open grassy areas with a soft reed bed fringe on the opposite side.

The project has been awarded the “Considerate Contractors Site Award Scheme 2007” for Site A & C. This award was presented by the Environment, Transport and Works Burea of the Hong Kong SAR.
